POTHOLE REPAIR

City Street Department crews are out repairing potholes caused by the freeze-thaw cycle. This work is prioritized based on size of pothole and location. Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Crews will continue this work as long as the weather allows. If there is a pothole in your neighborhood or on your daily route, you can report it by calling the pothole hotline at 625-7733. Please include as much information as possible on the location of the problem and its approximate size.



SNOW REMOVAL

The City's snow season runs until March 15, and City crews are monitoring street conditions 24 hours a day to ensure fast response as conditions change. When trucks are out, please do not attempt to pass them; it is very dangerous. A map with City snow plow routes and additional information on the City's snow removal plan is available on the City's [web site](#). The City starts plowing on arterials with about an inch of snow on the ground. Citizens can check the [progress of the plows](#) when weather conditions warrant their use. Citizens also can call our Snow Removal Hotline at 456-2666 for recorded information on the location of plows.
